

## Harrier Meet Won By Kearney, Avon

**BALDWINVILLE** — Bishop Kearney High and Avon Central captured both varsity races in large fields yesterday at the 16th Annual Baldwinville Invitational Cross Country Meet.

Competing against 22 "A" schools, Kearney's blue shirts finished with a 137-point total, ahead of Lowville's 172 and Oswego's 198. McQuaid, with 288, finished 11th and Aquinas 16th. Junior Jeff Eichner led the Kings in 12th place, followed by Mario D'Errico (23), Tom Aman (26), Bruce Velan (32), and Pat Gefell (44). McQuaid's Dean Stanley (21) and Bob Lawrence (22) and Aquinas' Jim Crawford (25) also finished well in the 161-runner field. Bob Buckley of Oswego was the individual winner, covering the 2.4 miles in 11:51.

Avon not only scored a convincing team victory over 18 other "B" schools but also had the top individual in senior Jerry Shaw. Backing up Shaw's 12:31 performance were Randy Stephenson (4), Bob Coyne (9), Fred Benz (12), and Dan Rumfola (25). It was the first time coach Len Hagberg's Avon team had run in the Baldwinville meet.

## Kearney Cross Country Team Snarers Diocesan Crown

Bishop Kearney senior Tom Aman took individual honors and led the blue-shirted Kings to their first diocesan varsity cross country championship yesterday at Watkins Glen. Aman's time of 12:20 over the muddy 2.3-mile hill course at Padua High School earned him the memorial trophy given for the first time in honor of Aquinas 1963 graduate Bob Bossert, who died on naval maneuvers as a midshipman in 1965. Bossert was cross-country and track captain for the Little Irish in his senior year.

Following Aman in Kearney's victory parade were Jeff Eichner (2), Mario D'Errico (3), Jim Maley (5), and Nick Habes (6). The Kings' team total was 17, with McQuaid runner-up at 51.

McQuaid packed four men into the top five behind Kearney's Paul Urlacher to capture JV laurels with 21 points to Kearney's 36.
