McQuaid Win Sparked By Farrell

NEW YORK — McQuaid, sparked by the fourth-place limsh of John Farrell, won the 28th annual Jesuit cross country meet yesterday in Van Cortlandt Park for the 3rd time in 11 years.

The Knights totaled 49 points with Fordham Prep of Brooklyn second with 58, and defending meet champion St. Joseph's Prep of Philadelphia accumulating 64 points and the third-place position.

Farrell was behind firstplace finisher Dennis Dunn of St. Joseph's, with the latter covering the 2.5-mile hilly course in 12 minutes, 56 seconds.

Other McQuaid finishers were Jack Reiser in 8th place, Tim Lawrence, Kevin Burnett and Andy Allen, 10th, 13th and 14th, respectively.

To the junior varsity race, where no team scoring was kept, McQuaid swept the first three places. Tom Horton, brother of recently graduated star Chris Horton, was first, with Dan Schoenherr and Paul Barton behind him.
