Runner of the Year

When graduation comes in June, McQuaid cross country coach Bob Bradley might feel like shedding a few tears. He'll be losing six of his top runners who helped McQuaid earn the Section 5 cross country championship.

Fortunately for Bradley, all is not lost. He'll still have Peter Glavin back — and Glavin's good enough to build a team around.

The talented junior, named Player of the Year in City-Catholic cross country, showed his worth to the senior-laden squad by winning the C-C title, and then in what Bradley calls his most impressive performance, Glavin finished fourth in the sectional meet and set a school record with a time of 14:34.

"He's an excellent pace runner," Bradley says. "He seems to have the ability to spread his race over the whole distance. At any time he looks like he has a lot of run in him."

Bradley's happy to have Glavin on his team, especially since Glavin could easily be playing soccer in the fall instead of running.

"He's a heck of a good soccer player, but when he came to McQuaid as an eighth grader, he wasn't eligible to go out for that (since McQuaid didn't have a junior high team)," Bradley says.
