

The 3rd annual ALL-SECTION V cross country team is again sponsored by the Greater Rochester Track Club, Dick Withrow--president, and the Section V cross country coaches.

This year's awards for the top seven male and female runners has the Sectional and Intersectional performances as the determining criteria. The formula used was to rank-order the performances by time in all the classes (AA, A, BC for the boys and A, B & C for the girls). Once the performances were rank-ordered for both the Sectionals and States, the States' performance was doubled in its significance. Thus, a numerical rank was arrived at that we could equitably judge all performers by. We could then determine who would be the top 7 male and female runners in Section V for 1983.
