MC QUAID WINS CLOSE ONE AT YORK X-C INVITATIONAL

The season's first invitational victory for McQuaid's new-look cross-country squad didn't come in quite the way coach Bob Bradley thought it might.

Instead of using a tight scoring group, as they often do, the Knights instead dominated the front of the race, putting 3 men in the top 5 and edging the superior group of Fairport's, 47-50, in the 9-team field at the York Invitational.

Leading the way for McQuaid was captain Dave Dugan, recovered from his leg miseries of last year. The slim senior moved through the field to take second place in 16:35 for the 3.05-mile course, 12 seconds behind winner Dave Dedman of Batavia. Just a few seconds behind in fourth and fifth places were senior Brad Sumner and junior Steve Foley. Senior Mickey Stone, after setting the early pace, held on to finish eleventh, and junior Jason Fahy slogged home in 25th spot, close enough to give the Knights their winning margin.

For Bradley, beginning his 27th year of coaching at McQuaid, the close win and Dugan's team-leading performance were both encouraging developments. "We have too much talent for us to call this a building year," said Bradley, "but I expected that our inexperience would keep us from doing much in the early meets. So this was a real plus."

So too was the Liverpool Invitational a week earlier, where Bradley would have been pleased with a top five finish and instead saw his team capture the third-place plaque. Scoring for the Knights in the 8-man relay-style competition that drew 22 schools were the same five from York plus seniors Andy Stone, Mike Sellar, and Greg Roberts. Foley recorded the fastest McQuaid time, 18:14, while placing second to Pittsford's Jeremy Ashfield in the second flight. In team scoring the Knights were a distant third to Pittsford's 29 but close to Baldwinsville's 60 and ahead of Corcoran(75) and Cicero-North Syracuse(81).

The McQuaid junior varsity teams took second place in both meets scoring 41 points to Pittsford's 14 at Liverpool and 36 points to Fairport's 23 at York. In the latter race, run in a steady downpour, the Knights' scoring team was juniors Matt Salata (2), Andy Reitz (3) and Chris Parks (12) and sophomores Dave Holmes (8) and Dan Gebhardt (11).

Sophomore Mark Spagnola, who led the J.V.'s at Liverpool with a fifth place finish after losing his lead by running off-course, ran on Friday due to a conflict and took a first in the Spencerport Invitational. Spagnola jumped out to an early lead, dropped back to second, then moved strongly in the last 200 meters to cover the 3 miles in 17:22.

This week the Knights will take part in the Harley-Allendale Invitational on Wednesday and split their weekend forces between the Guilderland and Newark meets on Saturday.
