McQuaid runners notch 3 wins in weekend meets

McQuaid Jesuit's cross country men regained their winning touch on all three levels while splitting their forces between Friday's Irondequoit-Penfield Invitational and Saturday's Southern Tier Classic at St. Bonaventure's campus in Olean.

The Knights, whose previous best at varsity level had been strong third-place finishes at Utica and Corning, found the winning combination to score 59 points and edge Frontier of Section 6 by 14 in a 13-school field.

Seniors Rob Way (fourth) and Jim Brasser (fifth) gave McQuaid its front strength, sophomore Conor Hickey (14) and senior Luke Flessner (15) were a strong middle, and junior Drew Kassmann (21) and Chip Galusha (22) did the clinching. Another junior, Ryan Dougherty, provided backup in 28th place.

Hickey's move into the heart of McQuaid's scoring group was an encouraging note for the Knights.

"Conor put in a 500-mile summer, and he's improving every time out," said coach Bob Bradley after the Olean victory. "That's the kind of push we need to match the groups of the other Section 5 contenders."

Another potential McQuaid scorer, senior Mark Bernal, competed on Friday at Penfield due to an SAT date on Saturday, and he,

too, came through with a strong race, placing 21st of 140 runners with a time of 17:55 over the tough Harris-Whalen Park course.

At the junior varsity level, the Knights' top group won its race at Olean by a 50-76 margin over Hornell in a 19-school field, and their next seven runners were a surprising third at Penfield.

Scoring at Olean were senior Nick Moeller (ninth), juniors Ian McBride (fourth) and Steve Holland (11), and sophomores Dan Burke (10) and Jacob Sciandra (16).

In a field of 197 runners at Penfield, the Knights put five in the top 30, led by juniors Matt Payne (18) and Ken Camann (19). Completing the scoring were seniors Sal Guarnieri (26) and Steve Chesterton (30) and fast-improving sophomore Marquis Wright (28).

McQuaid's most impressive victory of the weekend came from its junior high contingent and seventh-year coach Bill Dodd. Freshman Sunil Narayan posted the Knights' fastest time yet over the 1.5-mile course, winning in 8:05. Close behind in second and third were eighth-graders Matt Jones and Trevor Alvut, leaving seventh-grader Scott Rubino (seventh) and freshman Mike Coast (eighth) to complete the low score of 21.

MCQUAID RUNNERS STRUGGLE AGAINST STRONG COUNTY TEAMS

A month ago at the Marcus Whitman Invitational, McQuaid Jesuit's Knights bowed to three of the top county squads: Athena, Hilton, and Fairport. Last Saturday at the Seneca Invitational, they tasted defeat against three more of the county's best: Irondequoit, Gates-Chili, and Penfield. The scores read 52, 57, 88, and for McQuaid, 96.

"Throw in Churchville, which is ranked number one, and this is easily the strongest and deepest the county teams have been in all the years I've been around," said coach Bob Bradley after his team's latest strikeout. "I like to think we're right in there with them, but so far, we haven't run up to that level."

Saturday's misadventure saw the Knights looking good in the early going, but two of their top three at that point faded out of the scoring group, leaving only seniors Rob Way (7) and Luke Flessner (13) with finishes that matched those of the county trio. Mark Bernal (22), Drew Kassmann (26), and Chip Galusha (28) completed the scoring.

"I was pleased to see Luke that close to Rob up front," said Bradley. That's a real plus for us to build on in the nest few weeks."

Just about everything else at the choice Autumn setting that Seneca Park provided was on the plus side for the Knights. In the Varsity "B" race, they dominated the race early on and had a close-enough group to withstand a late charge from Athena's leaders, who finished 1-2-5. Senior JohnRyan Magill led his team in fourth place, followed by juniors Ian McBride (4) and Ryan Dougherty (8) and seniors Will Payne (7) and Tyler Lemcke (14).
