Grade: Junior.

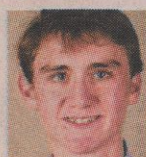
Parents: Catherine Meyler and Joshua Goodman.

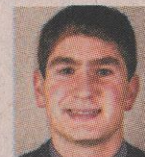
