Kearney Runners Take UR Development Mee

Miler Tom Aman and hurdler
Mike Leonard scored individual
victories to lead Bishop Kearney High to first place in yesterday's scholastic development
track and field meet at the U of
R Field House.

Aman, unbeaten this winter in the 1000 yards, mile and two-mile, edged the Pittsford Strid-ers' Tom Ritschard at the wire in the record time of 4:35.5. Ritschard, an exchange student from Switzerland, set the old mark of 4:42.2 two weeks ago. Leonard's winning time of 6.3

in the 45-yard high hurdles tied his own previous record and launched Kearney on its way to a 43-point total, best of the nine schools which competed.

Unattached athletes from another 15 schools swelled the meet to over 250 competitors.
