KEARNEY CAPTURES
AREA TRACK TITLE

Bishop Kearney's trackmen took eight firsts in twelve events to win the Rochester area championship over seven rivals in the scoring section of yesterday's scholastic indoor meet at University of Rochester field house.

The Kings totaled 78 1/2 points against runner-up McQuaid's 50. Only Bruce Tuttle of Alfred-Almond was able to break the Kearney monopoly in running events, taking the mile in a duel with Mooney's Bill Robinson and Kearney's Mike D'Errico.

In the development section of the meet, the record breakers took a break and only one new mark was established, that by Bishop Turner's Bill Traylor with a 36.4 time in the 13-14 300-yd dash.
