Two age-group records fell yesterday as 215 athletes from 17 Western New York schools got the scholastic indoor track season off and running at the University of Rochester field house.

Tom Staccone of Bishop Kearney lowered the 13-14 record for the 600 by a second with a 1:30.0 clocking, while Chick Kasouf of Christian Brothers Academy, Syracuse chopped over 9 seconds off the 15-16 two-mile mark with a 10:14.

The meet's two top performances, though, came in races that didn't quite break existing records. Tom Smith of Notre Dame, Utica won the 17-18 two-mile with an outstanding 9:55.2 but missed the 9:45.8 set by J Kearney's Mike Kelly 3 seasons back. Don Brown of CBA was just a tenth off the record of 1:33.8 with his winning 300 in 17-18 competition.

Next meet of the fast-growing development program at UR is set for Saturday, December 13, at 11 o'clock.

Alan Autovino of Eastridge, Joe Kuby of Bishop Kearney, and Laurie Stevens of Brockport were double winners yesterday in the season's second scholastic development track and field meet at the University of Rochester field house.

Autovino was top man in the 15-16 year 50 and 300 dashes, while Kuby was had the fastest times for the same 2 events in the 17-18 class. Miss Stevens won both girls' events, the 50 and the 225.

Only one record was lowered in the 3-hour meet, which saw 240 athletes from 27 schools competing in 63 events. Tom Staccone of Bishop Kearney did it, knocking his own 600 mark down to 1:28.1 in the 13-14 class.

Bishop Kearney's Darryl Youngman strided to a track record for the 600-yd run yesterday to head the list of gold medal winners in the Section V medal competition at UR field house.

The long-legged junior covered the distance in 1:16.8, well under the old mark of 1:19. He was one of four Kearney men who topped their Section V fields. Rick O'Connor and Rick Eichner, both juniors, captured the two-mile and mile, and senior Bob Masiulis threw the shot 51-2 3/4 to nip McQuaid's Terry Lee by less than an inch.

McQuaid had a pair of firsts in hurdler Tom Swiatek and its sprint medley team, while Webster ^{took} ~~was~~ a pair with 300-yd winner Jan Zabelny and its 4-lap relay squad, anchored by Zabelny.

Four schools had one gold medalist: Gates-Chili with Joe Nelson in the 50-yard dash; Batavia with Tom Moran in the 1000, Aquinas with Tom Sexton ~~in~~ in the high jump, and Brockport with Ed Welch in the pole vault.

In the development section of the meet, largely for out-of-area teams, Tim Hartman of Jamestown broke a second field house record with a 1000-yd time of 2:24.8. Earlier this winter, Hartman had lowered the 880 mark to 2:02.4.

The final two meets of the scholastic ~~indoor~~ indoor season are slated for next Friday night at 6:30 for younger age groups and at 11 A.M. on Saturday, the annual indoor invitational for athletes from all over upstate New York.

Three record-breakers and ~~several~~ double winners highlighted the fourth scholastic development track and field meet of the winter season yesterday at the University of Rochester field house.

One of the double winners--Jan Zabelny of Webster--also snared a record, sprinting the 15-16 division 300 in 34.8 ~~km~~ after his victory in the 50-yd dash. The other 2 records fell in 500-yard runs, Chuck Bachmann of Aquinas taking the 17-18 event in 1:05.5 and Tom Staccone of Bishop Kearney winning the 13-14 race in 1:12.3.

Five meet records fell and another was tied as Christian Brothers Academy of Syracuse successfully defended its title in yesterday's Fourth Annual ~~Inter-Scholastic~~ Rochester Interscholastic Relays held at UR field house.

The Brothers, despite being blanked in 3 events, totaled 39½ points to runner-up Bishop Kearney's 27 and St. Ignatius of Cleveland's 24.

The record-breaking began in the meet's first final when Brian Quinn of St. Joseph's, Buffalo broke away in the last 250 yards to set a two-mile mark of 9:49.9. Tom Swiatek of McQuaid followed with a record-tying 6.0 victory in the 45-yard high hurdles, and McQuaid's Terry Lee hefted the shot 51 feet, 2½ inches to shatter the second mark by over 3 feet.

Three relay marks were lowered, beginning with an 8:55.4 by St. Ignatius in the 16-lap event. Kearney shaved its own 15-lap medley record down to 8:24.2 on a strong anchor leg by Rich Eichner, and CBA chopped almost 8 seconds off the old 8-lap medley record with a 3:51.8.

A feature of the non-scoring development section of the meet was a 6-3 high jump by Jeff Flanders of Jamestown Southwestern High, setting a high school record for the field house.

Next meet on the indoor schedule is a Section V Medal Competition set for Saturday, Feb. 21. at 9:30 in the field house.

Bill Ezzo of Canastota sprinted to a 5.4 victory in the 50; Tim Hartman of Jamestown lowered his own ~~field~~ mark in the 1000 to 2:22.6; Brian Quinn of St. Joseph's, Buffalo came from behind on the last lap to take the mile in 4:31.6; and Jeff Flanders of Southwestern High in Jamestown got his Fosbury Flop high jump up to a 6-4 $\frac{1}{4}$.

The fifth record went to Don Brown of CBA, Syracuse who nipped Kearney's Darryl ~~Youngman~~ Youngman in a 1:16.9 600. Youngman last week had set the field house record of 1:16.8, but he was a half-stride away yesterday.

Three local standouts came up with championships against stiff out-of-town competition. Kearney's Joe Kuby flashed the 225 in 24.9; his teammate, Bob Masiulis, posted a new school record of 52-7 $\frac{1}{4}$ in the shot put; and Webster's Jeff Lagendyk won the pole vault at 11-6.

Team honors went to defending champion CBA with a 45 $\frac{1}{2}$ -point total. Kearney was runner-up with 27, and Bradford(Pa.) High was third with 20.

In the development section of the meet, 16 new season bests were posted by athletes in the younger age groups, as they too wound up their indoor season.
