

Bill Soeffing m of Charlotte, and Norman Felton of Madison, and Martha Thompson of Brockport were double winners yesterday in the fourth development track and field meet at the University of Rochester field house.

Soeffing was an age group winner in the high hurdles and 50-yard dash; Felton took firsts in the 50 and 300; and Miss Thompson won both girls' dashes in the younger age group.

One development record was broken, that by Alex Trammell of St. Joseph's, Buffalo, with a fast 1:03.1 in the 15-16 500-yard run.

Competition in the shot put saw two men crack the 51-foot mark, with Lockport's Doug Langdon edging McQuaid's Terry Lee by 3 inches with a toss of 51-4.

The largest turnout of the indoor track season produced three new records and five double winners yesterday in high school action at the University of Rochester field house.

With almost 350 athletes from 32 Western New York schools competing, Bill Soeffing of Charlotte, Pat Sanders of Jamestown Southwestern, and Norman Felton of Madison emerged with two age-group wins each in boys' events, while Amy Tuttle of Alfred-Almond and Lori Stephens of Brockport each captured a pair of girls' sprints.

The record breaking was led by Aquinas junior Dan Ambrose, who raced to his third x mark in the 15-16 division with a 1:18 for the 600. Ambrose previously had set records in the 880 and mile. It was the first venture at the shorter distance for the Little Irish star. In the same division, Sanders upped the high jump mark three inches to 5-10, as did N Ben Davis of Monroe, who lost to Sanders in a jump-off. The third record went to Cardinal Mooney's Mike Yargeau, who covered the 13-14 mile in 5:01.

In a non-record highlight, Lockport's Doug Langdon and McQuaid's Terry Lee continued their shot put duelling, with Langdon nipping Lee by an inch with a distance of 51-10½. Lee's toss was a new McQuaid record.

High school track action shifts next week to Syracuse U.'s Manley Field House, returning to UR on January 30.

Aquinas junior Dan Ambrose continued his record-breaking yesterday by chopping over four seconds off the age-group 880 mark to highlight the weekly track and field development meet at the University of Rochester field house.

Ambrose, who had lowered the 15-16 mile standard by 10 seconds last week, ran away again yesterday, winning by over 50 yards in 2:04. The old record of 2:08.4 was set last year by Tom Moran of Batavia, who led yesterday's 17-18 880 only to be overhauled in the last ~~330~~ 300 yards by Kearney's Darrell Youngman, the winner in 2:03.8.

For the third straight week, Kearney's Tom Campione was a double winner in the 17-18 pole vault and high jump. Teammate Paul Stauffer also won a pair in the 13-14 sprints. The girls' competition had a double winner in ~~13-14 sprinter~~ Marti Farnham of Gates-Chili, who ~~he~~ took both 13-14 sprints.

Scholastic track action takes a holiday now until Saturday, Jan. 9, when the development series ~~resumes~~ resumes at UR, pointing towards championship meets in February and March.

Tom Campione of Bishop Kearney and Joe Palumbo of Aquinas were double winners yesterday as some 350 athletes from 18 Western New York schools got the scholastic indoor track and field season under way at the University of Rochester field house.

#### 17-18 year old

Campione, a senior, took the pole vault at 11-6 and the high jump at 5-8. Palumbo, a freshman, won the 13-14 year old hurdles and 50-yard dash. His 7.1 time in the hurdles was the only age-group record of the meet.

In the two top races of the program, Kearney's Kevin Hanna kicked home in front of the 2-mile field with a 10:04 victory, and Don Brown of CBA, Syracuse nipped Kearney's Darrell Youngman in the 880.

Local track standouts R Darrell Youngman, Dan Ambrose, and Bill Soeffing set new age group records in their events to highlight yesterday's scholastic development meet at the University of Rochester field house.

Youngman, a Bishop Kearney senior, sprinted the 500 in 1:03.2, breaking his last year's mark by over a second. Ambrose, an Aquinas junior, ran away with the mile in ~~xxxxxx~~ 4:31.6, not only shattering ~~the~~ ~~xxxxxx~~ age-group record by 10 seconds but tying the track record for high schoolers. Soeffing, a Charlotte junior, lowered the ~~xxxxxx~~ 45-yard hurdles time to 6.2.

For the second week in a row, Kearney's Tom Campione was a double winner in the pole vault and ~~high~~ high jump, getting up to 5-11 in the latter event. Bishop Kearney's indoor track men, scoring in all but one event, finally broke the championship monopoly of Syracuse's Christian Brothers Academy yesterday in the Fifth Annual Rochester Relays.

The Kings did it decisively, scoring 47 points to the Brothers' 26 and the 20 of third-place St. Ignatius High of Cleveland. Twenty-one schools and clubs from Western New York competed despite the stormy weather.

Five new meet records went into the books, one of them by Kearney's 15-lap medley team which lowered its own mark to 8:23 on a brilliant 4:34 anchor leg of 1800 yards by Rick Eichner. Kearney's other winners were its 16-lap team, two-miler Rick O'Connor, and pole vaulter Tom Campione. CBA's only victory came in the 8-lap medley, where Kearney's Tom Neary came from way back but couldn't overhaul CBA anchorman Don Brown.

Also claiming meet records were shot putter Doug Langdon of Lockport, who topped McQuaid's Terry Lee by 11 inches with a toss of 53-3 1/2; high-jumper Mark Hiestand of Liverpool with a Fosbury Flop of 6-2 1/2; St. Joseph's Track Club's 8-lap team, which chopped over 7 seconds off the old mark with an outstanding outran 3:44.5 clocking; and the 4-lap relay team of St. Ignatius, which ~~outdistanced~~ CBA in one of the meet's best races for a 1:41.7 time.

A three-way battle for team honors went down to the final race yesterday  
as Christian Brothers Academy of Syracuse ~~missed~~ edged Bishop Kearney and Liverpool

in the Fifth Annual Rochester Indoor Invitational at UR field house.

Going into the ~~final~~ four-lap relay, it was Liverpool 40, CBA 39, Kearney 38.  
With CBA taking a second and Kearney a third while Liverpool went scoreless, the  
final score became CBA 43, Kearney 41, Liverpool 40. It was the Brothers third  
~~invitational~~ title in as many years.

Though ~~the Kings~~ Kearney missed out in its bid for team honors, the Kings  
had considerable satisfaction in accounting for all three of the new meet records.  
Two of them--by Tom Neary and Rick Eichner--were field house records as well.  
Neary outduelled Jim Herr of CBA and Alex Trammell of St. Joseph's, Buffalo in  
a 2:21.7 1000-yd battle that saw all 3 men break the old mark of 2:22.6. Eichner  
topped Tim McMullen of Spencerport in the mile, shaving the previous record of  
4:31.6 by a tenth. The third record went to the Kearney 8-lap medley team, which  
Darrell Youngman anchored to a 4:01.6, also a tenth under the old record.

A fourth record was tied by Liverpool's Mark Hiestand with a 12-foot pole  
vault. Hiestand was also the meet's only double winner, going 6-3 in the high  
jump for ~~an unblemished~~ his second trophy.

~~Thereby~~ Besides Kearney's record-breakers, the only local entries to  
best the out-of-town competition were Terry Lee of McQuaid with a 53-10 effort  
in the shot put, almost 17 inches better than his old school record, and Kearney's  
Rick O'Connor, who ran away with the tow-mile in 9:49.9.

~~Summary~~ The meet concluded the local indoor season, except for a Section V  
winter carnival meet scheduled for March 27.
