Warth anchors winning relays

His leg of 4:22.9 in the distance medley was the best area mile time of the season. He combined with Tom McGrath, Joe Eckl and Mike Das to set a meet record of 11:00.9 in the distance medley race.

Greg Reyner of Cardinal Mooney set a meet record of 59-5 to capture the shot put, Grant Whitney of Penfield won the 3,200meter race in 9:36.1, and Pete Young of Fairport won the high jump in 6-4. Monroe's foursome of Jerrill Wright, Kevin Presha, Pat Pate and Kevin Burroughs won the 800-meter relay in 1:38.9 and the 1,600-meter with a time of 3:44.7.

Sweet Home won the boys' team title with 35 points. Penfield was second with 29 and McQuaid was third with 28. Keith Clark of
