

Schoolboy Records Broken

ANNAPOLIS, Md., March 12 — Derrick Love of Fort Meade, Md., and an 880-yard relay quartet from Hawthorne, Calif., registered schoolboy indoor records today at the National Scholastic track and field championships in the Naval Academy Field House.

Love took the 200-meter dash in 21.99 seconds but his time of 21.59 sec-

onds in a preliminary heat of the 200 set the national mark. He also won the 55-meter dash in 6.28 seconds.

Hawthorne's foursome of Chris Alexander, Anthony Smith, Eric Allen and Curtis Conway was timed in 1 minute 28.25 seconds, almost half a second under the previous record. Conway, an all-America quarterback bound for Southern Cal, ran 21.5 seconds for his leg.

Dion Bentley of Pittsburgh, who set a national record of 26 feet 6½ inches in the long jump two weeks ago, posted a meet mark of 25 feet 11½ inches today but was disappointed with his efforts. "I really wanted to do 27 feet today," the senior said. Bentley fouled on what appeared to be near that mark. He had other jumps of 25-7½, 25-3½, 24-6 and 23-6.

Brad Sumner of Rochester, who set a national indoor record Saturday of 1:19.56 for 600 meters at the New York State championships in Ithaca, turned in two impressive gold-medal performances today. He won the 800-meter run in 1:55.29 and came back later to bring McQuaid Jesuit High School a victory in the two-mile relay (7:59.30) with a 1:54.6 split as anchor-man.

Todd Orvis, who also won a state title Saturday at 1,600 meters (4:14.90), ran a strong one-mile race today and finished first in 4:13.99, a personal best.
