STATE QUALIFIER

Webster sprinter wins 2, ties mark

Webster's Renee Henderson tied a Section 5 record in the 45-meter dash and was the only double winner in yesterday's meet at the University of Rochester.

Henderson posted a winning time of 5.90 seconds in the 45 dash, edging Zilla Higgs of East (.06.0). Henderson doubled in the 300 (:42.80).

Rachel Hosmer of Brighton won the 1,000 (:58.9) and won the Father Wesley Award as the outstanding competitor of the girls' sectionals and state qualifier. In the other girls' short-distance event, Fairport senior Kim Serbu captured the 600 in 1:43.10.

Penfield won the 1,600 and 3,200 relays while East triumphed in the 800 relays.

Brad Sumner of McQuaid set a meet record in the boys' 600 (1:21.10). Sumner also combined with Scott Romanowski, Mickey Stone and Jason Fahey for a meet record in 1,600 relay (3:30.5).

Sumner earned the Father Wesley Award for his performances in boys' sectionals and the qualifier.

Penfield's Nathan Sacco won the 3,200 (9:37.9) and helped his team win the 3,200 relay. His brother, Tyson, ran on the intersectional medley relay. Franklin captured the 800 relay.
