## McQuaid runners record top indoor performances

As the Rochester Winter Track League reaches its halfway point, McQuaid Jesuit's indoor track and field men are well represented on the list of Section 5's best performances.

Three of those times came last Saturday as the Knights journeyed to Hamilton College and came home with the Class A trophy in the annual Section 3 Invitational.

Most impressive was the 1:23.9 victory recorded by junior Shawn Watts at 600 meters. Watts, who already had the area best of 1:25.7, had to chase Henninger's Steve Cooper almost all the way. The pair went through a sub-54 400, and Watts wasn't able to take the lead until the homestretch, when he battled his way past Cooper to win by two-tenths.

"Shawn is really developing into an outstanding runner," said Coach Bob Bradley. "I mentioned to him that Brad Sumner's best time as a junior was a 1:23.3 at Hamilton, so he was psyched for a fast race. He showed a lot of guts winning it from behind." (Sumner holds the national 600 record of 1:19.56, set at Cornell in his senior year of 1989. He's now Villanova's top middle distance runner.)

When he came back for the 1,000 two hours later, Watts wasn't quite up to another fast race. Already the holder of Section 5's best at 2:37.6, he tried to set a slower pace and held the lead

until Liverpool's Joe Head took over at the half-way mark. Watts made a bid for another comeback win in the last 50 meters, but Head turned on his own kick and won in 2:40.8. Watts ran a good 2:41.3.

The McQuaid junior also has the top 800 mark (1:59.7), and is among the leaders in the 300 (38.2 seconds) and 1600 (4:40.1).

Senior Eric Garsin has area bests in the 1500 and 1600, the latter coming at Hamilton in an eyelash 4:30.7 victory over Utica's John Syrotinski. Garsin found himself in fifth place behind teammate Adam Reitz with three laps to go, but he worked his way into the lead in the next 300. He seemed on his way to a comfortable win before Syrotinski's closing spurt just missed nipping him. Reitz was third in a PR 4:33.3.

Garsin, the area leader in the 1500 (4:16.4), also had the best 3200 time (10:00) until teammate Dan Lesser topped that with a 9:52.3 at Hamilton. Lesser, the 3000 leader with a fast 9:12.8 at Brown last month, hooked up with Rome's Eric Foley, one of upstate's top distance men for four years. Foley jumped right into the lead and never let Lesser pass him.

"Dan must have tried 10 times," said Bradley, "but Foley picked it up just enough to keep him out and then

outkicked him." In the same race, senior Matt Bunce kept contact with Lesser most of the way and wound up fourth with a PR 10:05.5.

Lesser and Garsin both returned to run 800 legs on winning relays. Lesser's 2:09.9 anchor was good enough to give the Knights a sprint medley win, with senior Mark Beresiewicz running the 400 leadoff and Tim Tyre and Bunce handling the 200 legs. Garsin's 2:05.4 leadoff opened up a good lead for McQuaid's 3200-meter team, and it won easily on good efforts by Dave Corsall (2:12.4), Jim Barnum (2:11.8), and Reitz (2:07.9).

The Knights' 3200 team posted an area best over the Christmas break when they traveled to the Brown University Invitational and finished fourth in 8:20.4. Garsin, Bunce, Watts, and Barnum combined for that effort, but Bradley expects to have Reitz and senior Tim Kelley in the lineup by season's end. Kelley has missed the last four meets after undergoing an emergency appendectomy on Christmas night.

"It seems strange not to see Tim's name on the list of bests because he's been there for three years. But he should be able to practice again soon and maybe even get into competition in a month."

The trip to Providence also produced the fastest indoor distance medley Section 5 has had since the Knights posted a 10:22.3 at Yale in 1985. This time, the clock showed a modest 10:42.1, coming from a 1200 by Garsin (3:13.2), a 54.1 400 by Joe Tiffany, a 1:59.9 800 by Watts, and Lesser's 4:34.9 anchor leg of 1600. That brought them a fifth place in an elite race of 11 top teams from the Northeast. Chaminade High of Long Island won in 10:31.

At Hamilton, McQuaid's third winning relay was the 800-meter team, which had its fastest time of the season, 1:38.2. Last year's record-setting (1:33.9) group has been replaced with a senior-soph combination of Tiffany and Beresiewicz and newcomers Tim Tyre and Alan LaChapelle. On Saturday, Tiffany's 24.2 lead-off got his team right out there, and Beresiewicz's 24.3 anchor put the Knights in position for the win when Henninger was disqualified for a zone violation.

The Knights' final eight points came from high-jumpers Tiffany and Brian Kubiak, who tied for third with 5-8. Their team total of 92 topped Henninger's 70 and Rome Free's 66 among eight A-schools.

This weekend's RWTL action at the University of Rochester shifts to a Friday night slot, beginning at 5 p.m.

## Reitz, Tiffany pace McQuaid trackmen

Junior Adam Reitz and senior Joe Tiffany shared top honors for McQuaid's indoor track team in last Friday's RWTL meet at the University of Rochester.

Reitz, who's been developing his middle distance skills as a change of pace from a steady distance diet, had the fastest 800-meter time of the long evening, 2:05.4. He took the lead after 300 meters, went through his 400 in sub-60, and won comfortably over a field that included teammates Dan Lesser (a PR 2:06.6) and Jim Barnum (2:10.4).

In a previous RWTL meet, Reitz had won a fast 600 (1:29.2) to go with the good times in his usual events, the 1600 and 3200.

Earlier he and Tiffany had run

strong legs on McQuaid's winning 4 x 2-lap relay team. Senior Mark Beresiewicz's lead-off leg was the key for the Knights, said McQuaid coach Bob Bradley. "The U of R track is not an easy one to pass on, and Mark made a great move right at the start to get us out into the lead. Reitz extended that margin slightly, and junior Jim Barnum kept his team in front for the pass to Tiffany. Edison's anchor man challenged for the lead, but Tiffany pulled away on the final lap.

Tiffany just missed a double win in the hurdles, being nipped by an Edison runner while posting a PR 6.0 for the 40-meter event.

In the 200-meter races, a new distance for RWTL meets, McQuaid's young sophomore sprinters all showed

well. Tim Tyre had the fastest time of the Knight entries, a 25.8 that earned him a second place. Next were Alan LaChapelle (26.2), Marc Corea (26.6), and Alex Perez (26.7).

Seniors Rob Bradley (4:42.6) and Jesse Yeager (4:44.0) placed third and fourth in their section of the 1500, a race won by Brighton's C.R. Gash.

In field events, shotputter Harry Gill and triple jumper Greg Schlachter both had PR's, though neither placed.

This Saturday, McQuaid will join a few other Section 5 entries in the annual Western New York Relays hosted by Section 6, this year at the spacious University of Buffalo arena, beginning at 2 p.m. The Knights will also have entries in the local RWTL meet at U of R, beginning at 10:30 a.m.

# Records tumble in Engineer Games

## Middleton, Hopkins, VanCott register Section II marks

TROY — Jamie Middleton of Troy established a Section II record in the triple jump, Trista Hopkins and Dan VanCott equalled Section II standards and Shaker and Shenendehowa walked away with the team titles Saturday at the annual Engineer Games indoor track meet at Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute's Robison Gym.

Middleton hopped, skipped and jumped to a Section II record 48-¾ on his final attempt to take the title

away from Schenectady junior Jahez Salahuddin. Salahuddin produced a 48-¾ on his last attempt, which momentarily gave him the lead as well as the Section II record.

Middleton uncorked his winning jump moments later, surpassing former Section II record holder Ed Rosiewicz of Shaker, registered a 47-1½ during the 1978 indoor season, as well as Salahuddin.

The efforts of Middleton and Salahuddin, who earlier had a leap of 49-0 disallowed on a foot foul, puts them in solid contention for a state title.

"Those two were really duking it out. It was a great performance by both kids," said Troy coach Ed Cepiel, who coordinated the meet. "That was probably the most hotly contested event of the day."

An eighth-grader from Burnt Hills with plenty of promise, Hopkins

equalled Bridgett Reilly's Section II 300-meter standard of 41.2, which the Guilderland product churned out in 1980. Hopkins held off highly-regarded Zilla Higgs of East High for the title.

VanCott, from Saratoga, posted a 5.3 in the 45-meter dash to tie the Section II record held jointly by Chuck Matthews of Albany Academy and Lemel Covington of Troy, as well as the meet record.

Including Middleton's 48-¾, seven meet records were broken.

"That was kind of a surprise. Coming in I didn't think we were going to have that kind of quality," said Cepiel. "A lot of kids really came through."

Among the more impressive meet records set was a high jump of 6-8½ by Schenectady senior Phil Bergeron, which was just 1½ inch off the Section II record held jointly by George Brewer of Albany and Shane Cassidy of Saratoga.

Bergeron, whose previous best was a 6-7 last season, broke his own meet record of 6-4, also set in 1991.

"I started off this season kind of slow. I was having some problems with my approach, but now that I've got it down I'm starting to go," said Bergeron, who just missed on his third attempt a 6-9½ when his left heel clipped the bar. "My goal is to go 6-10. I feel I can make that."

Coming off a first place performance at the Jan. 19 Dutchmen Games, Salahuddin placed second in the high jump at 6-4½.

"Last year I didn't have anyone to push me," Bergeron said. "It's good to have Jahez competing with me. We push each other, but we also help each other out."

Other boys' meet records were set by Michael Ford of East High, a heavily-recruited senior who captur-

ed both the 300 (35.6) and the long jump (22-¼).

Girls' meet records were broken by East High's Zilla Higgs in the 45-meter dash (5.9); Niki Williamson of Albany High in 50-meter hurdles (7.6), who edged defending champ Jen Petersen of Fonda by .1 second; and by Troy sophomore Dion Gardner in the triple jump (37-4½). Gardner won the triple jump for the second year in a row, bettering her 1991 meet-record effort of 36-½ with a 37-4½. She also placed third in the long jump.

Burnt Hills junior Evita Castine was another standout in the girls' competition, winning both the 1,000 (3:10.6) and 600-meter (1:40.1) runs.

Shaker captured its second consecutive team title with 55 points to outdistance Burnt Hills (43), Albany (41), Niskayuna (30) and East High (30). Shaker piled up 20 of its points by winning both the 3,200 and 1,600 relay events in 9:52.5 and 4:15.7, respectively.

Cheryl McMillan highlighted Shaker's 3,200 relay performance with a season-best 2:25.6 opening leg, which put the Blue Bison into an early lead. Tara Hebert and Sally Endemann stretched their advantage, with Krissy Haacke running the anchor leg in 2:24.1.

Haacke clocked a school record 5:04.52 and placed fourth Friday night in the Invitational High School Girls' Mile at the Millrose Games at Madison Square Garden. The star

junior returned to the Capital Region early Saturday morning.

"She can feel it from last night," said Shaker coach Mary Beth Steffen, who also had Haacke run a leg on the team's winning 1,600 relay. "She's tired but she ran well. They all ran well. They ran to win."

Hebert, Sara Clark, Haacke and McMillan joined forces to capture the 1,600 relay in 4:12.5, which was 4.9 seconds faster than at the Dutchmen Games. Shaker received additional key points from Endemann, who placed second in the 1,000; Madhu Pudda, who placed second in the long jump and fourth in the triple jump; and Aixa Olazagasti, who placed third in the triple jump.

"It was a great team effort. We came here with 12 girls and 11 of them scored points," said Steffen. "It's nice to come back and take it for the second straight year."

Dutchmen Games team champion Shenendehowa made it two in a row, racking up 85 points to garner the boys' championship. Sidney placed second with 58 points, followed by McQuaid (40), which took two of the three relays, and Schenectady (37).

Shenendehowa's Andrew White missed a meet record by .1 second in defending his 50-meter hurdles title in 6.9. Other winners for Shenendehowa's boys' contingent were Tom Monticup, who went 12-9 in the pole vault, and DeLucia, who copped the 1,000-meter run in 2:38.3.

# McQuaid runners capture Section 5 indoor championship

Scoring in every event – a sectional first – for a total of 125 points – a sectional record – McQuaid Jesuit's indoor track and field men captured the Class A Section 5 championships at the University of Rochester last Saturday.

Fifteen of the 23 Knights entered in the meet came through with scoring performances as McQuaid won by a surprisingly large margin over runner-up Fairport (78) and Penfield (63) in the 13-school field.

The first four events proved decisive, as McQuaid's jumpers and runners opened up a 50-12 lead over the Red Raiders. In the 3,200, Coach Peter Glavin's distance trio of Adam Reitz, Dan Lesser, and Matt Bunce garnered 18 points with a 2-3-4 finish. In the 1000, Coach Dave Warth's middle-distance duo of Tim Kelley and Eric

Garsin led all the way en route to PR's 2:39.2 and 2:39.8, good for another 18 points.

In the high jump, where Fairport had four qualifiers, the Knights' kept the Raiders from a possible rally by taking a second, tie for fourth, and a sixth for 12 points, while the Raiders could manage only a third and a tie for fourth for 9. Senior Steve Parrish cleared 5-10 on his first try to tie Penfield's Dan Aken for first, but Aken took the win on a jump-off at 5-11. Juniors Joe Tiffany and Dave Rimlinger had indoor PR's of 5-10 and 5-8 to score their points.

Sophomore Shawn Watts, one of seven Knights to score in three events, completed the early surge by taking a fifth in the long jump while Fairport went scoreless.

Parrish and Tiffany came back later to take a 5-6 in the hurdles and Tiffany completed his triple by running the second leg on the Knights' winning 1,600 relay.

The relays, which figured to be crucial, came at the end of the 10-hour meet, when McQuaid had already clinched the title, but the Knights provided a meet highlight by winning all three, two in spectacular fashion.

In the 3,200, Watts took the lead on his leg, but Fairport's Greg Poole came back to send the Raiders ahead after two legs. Kelley then popped a 2:02.1 third leg to overtake Fairport's Paul Grassi, and anchorman Mike Keogh had a PR 2:04.5 to win by a yard. The Knights' time of 8:18.9 was a new high school mark for that event at the U of R.

The next relay, the 1,600, was another see-saw, with Penfield joining the Knights and Raiders as leaders. After Damon Wade and Tiffany had left the Knights a close third, junior

Les Bernard gave them a lead that anchor Kris Weldon preserved with a 52.8 leg under heavy pressure from Penfield's Mark Elliott.

Wade, Bernard, and Weldon were joined by Keogh for a meet-ending victory in the 800 relay, which saw the Knights pull away on the last two legs for a 1:35.8, their fastest ever at U of R.

Earlier, that foursome had contributed another 22 points in individual events. Weldon and Bernard took a 2-4 in the 300, both with their U of R bests, Keogh ran a strong 1:27.0 for second in the 600, and Wade tied the school record at 5.6 while taking fifth in the 45.

Garsin, whose 18 1/2 points led McQuaid's 15 scorers, ran a PR 4:36.3 to place second in the mile, while Lesser was 10 seconds back in sixth. That finished off the 100 points McQuaid totaled in the running events.

In the field, McQuaid's surprising harvest of 25 points was completed by a 4-6 from Coach Ted Mooney's shot-putters, Steve Wampler and Adam Missell, a fifth at 10-6 by Wampler in the pole vault, and a PR 41-1 1/4 by Watts for a fourth in the triple jump.

"This has to be one of our very best sectionals," said Coach Bob Bradley, whose Knights have had some good ones over the years. "It was great to see our guys coming through right down the line, even when they didn't score."

This week, all of Section 5's track and field athletes will compete together in the state qualifier Meet of Champions at the U of R, beginning at 10 a.m. The Knights will try to qualify their 3,200 and 800 relays as well as a handful of individuals for spots in the following week's state meet at Cornell.

# 8 McQuaid runners advance to state indoor track meet

Last Saturday's Meet of Champions at the University of Rochester saw five McQuaid runners post personal bests and the sprint relay team extend its unbeaten skein to 10 as eight Knights qualified for the state meet at Cornell.

Sophomore distance men Adam Reitz and Dan Lesser made it clear that they were shooting for fast times when they jumped right out into the lead in the meet's first final, the 3,200. Race favorite Dan Cook of Greece joined them at the front a few laps later and the three pulled away from the field as they ran the first sub-10 race of the season locally.

Reitz and Lesser came through the mile with Cook in 4:51, and with a half-mile to go, Reitz moved away to an upset win over the Greece senior. His time of 9:43.2, a PR of more than 18 seconds, bested Cook by 15 yards as both men qualified.

Lesser's third-place time of 9:59.3, a PR by eight seconds, didn't get him to states in that event. So he came back three hours later and ran his best 1,600, 4:37.9, to finish third and qualify for a spot on the Section 5 intersectional medley team.

The PR theme prevailed for the next two events, the 1,000 and 600, where

three more Knights qualified. Juniors Tim Kelley and Eric Garsin, the top seeds in the 1,000, had their hands full with Spencerport's Bob Stewart for the whole race. Going into the final 200 meters, Stewart was sandwiched between the two, but Garsin was able to get past him in the home stretch and

also to nip Kelley for the first time this season in a 2:38.3 PR. Kelley's 2:38.6 was also a PR.

Senior Mike Keogh picked the 600 as his first event to qualify for States, and he, too, had to come up with a PR to make it. Fairport's Mike Reif led from start to finish, as expected, but Keogh's second-place spot received a serious last-lap challenge from Hornell's long-striding Tim Shepard. Keogh held him off on the backstretch and maintained a slim lead over the last 100 meters, finishing in 1:26.4.

The other McQuaid individual qualifier was senior Kris Weldon, who was aiming for a spot in the 300 and a chance to break the school record of 36.6 on the fast Cornell track this Saturday. But Weldon's 37.5 placed him fourth, good enough to join Lesser, Stewart, and Shepard on the sectional medley team.

Weldon will also be in action with McQuaid's 800-meter relay, which he has anchored to 10 victories without a loss this season. The Knights won their semifinal and final races comfortably to earn the spot as Section 5's representative. In the final, junior Les Bernard and Keogh touched senior Damon Wade off a few yards behind Edison, but Wade's best leg of the season, a 23.2, broke the race open, and

Weldon's 23.2 gave McQuaid a 20-yard win in 1:35.4, their fastest ever at the U of R.

The sole disappointment of the meet came in the 3,200 relay, where the Knights ran into a pumped-up Fairport team and came away second best. Their team time of 8:18.7 was a shade faster than the winning 8:18.9 that beat Fairport by a few steps in the sectionals, but the Red Raiders put together an 8:15.7 to earn the victory.

After McQuaid soph Shawn Watts and Fairport's Paul Grassi had touched their men off almost even, Fairport's Greg Poole opened up a 20-yard lead on the second leg that decided the outcome. "I thought the race would go right down to the wire," said Knights coach Bob Bradley, "but our guys seemed tired from their other races, and Fairport just stayed out there."

The eight qualifiers, along with relay alternates Mark Beresiewicz and Steve Parrish, will head down to Cornell Friday on the sectional bus. First event Saturday will go at 10 a.m.

"Based on past years, our spring relay team has a good shot at the top three, though we'll probably be seeded around sixth," said Bradley. "Kris and Dan should score with the sectional medley team, too. I expect our other guys to place well in their sections and get PR's, but they'll really have to have breakthroughs to score. It will be a great experience for them, though, and they deserve it after the season they've had."



## Misfortune strikes McQuaid runners

McQuaid Jesuit's 800-meter relay finished its season undefeated in Saturday's state meet, and the Knights were anything but happy about it.

In the morning semifinal race at Cornell's fast Barton Hall track, McQuaid rode a 22.5 anchor leg by senior Kris Weldon to a spectacular come-from-behind win over Wingate High of Brooklyn in a school-record 1:33.9. But a passing-zone violation had the red flag up and a disqualification finished the Knights for the day.

In the later-afternoon final, Weldon and teammates Les Bernard, Mike Keogh, and Damon Wade sat gloomily in the stands and watched Wingate edge Walt Whitman of Section 11 for the 800 title in 1:32.8.

"It's tough when it happens in the state meet," McQuaid coach Bob Bradley said.

"But it's part of sprint-relay running and our guys took it well. No telling what would have happened if we had been in the finals, but I think we would have been right up with the top two."

The relay was McQuaid's main scoring hope, but its next best bet — the intersectional medley — had Weldon and sophomore Dan Lesser as half of a strong Section 5 team. That hope faded, too, with a slow opening 1,000-meter leg that left the Section 5 purple shorts far behind.

Weldon's 23.0 200 leg, a good

1:26.4 by Hornell's Dave Shepard, and Lesser's 4:38.4 anchor 1,600 leg could bring them up no higher than seventh.

Of the Knights individual entries, Keogh fared best running a personal-record 1:26.0 to finish second in his race and 13th overall of 25 competitors.

Sophomore Adam Reitz didn't match his 9:43 victory of the previous week in the 3,200, but his 9:51.1 placed him 10th overall. Greece's Dan Cook, winning the slower section, in 9:40.7, placed sixth overall, one of Section 5's four individuals to score.

Juniors Eric Garsin and Tim Kelley also fell short of PR times in the 1,000. Clocking 2:39.2 and 2:43.1 to finish in the middle of the 27-runner field spread over three races.

This weekend, McQuaid's indoor season will end in the Carrier Dome in the national championships on Saturday.

The Knights will field a distance medley team of Kelley, Weldon, Keogh, and Garson on Sunday.

Reitz will be in the unseeded two-mile and Weldon, Keogh, Bernard, and Wade will be going after the Section 5 record of 3:25.75 in the 1,600 relay.
