McQuaid runners record top indoor performances

As the Rochester Winter Track League reaches its halfway point, McQuaid Jesuit's indoor track and field men are well represented on the list of Section 5's best performances.

Three of those times came last Saturday as the Knights journeyed to Hamilton College and came home with the Class A trophy in the annual Section 3 Invitational.

Most impressive was the 1:23.9 victory recorded by junior Shawn Watts at 600 meters. Watts, who already had the area best of 1:25.7, had to chase Henninger's Steve Cooper almost all the way. The pair went through a sub-54 400, and Watts wasn't able to take the lead until the homestretch, when he battled his way past Cooper to win by two-tenths.

"Shawn is really developing into an outstanding runner," said Coach Bob Bradley. "I mentioned to him that Brad Sumner's best time as a junior was a 1:23.3 at Hamilton, so he was psyched for a fast race. He showed a lot of guts winning it from behind." (Sumner holds the national 600 record of 1:19.56, set at Cornell in his senior year of 1989. He's now Villanova's top middle distance runner.)

When he came back for the 1,000 two hours later, Watts wasn't quite up to another fast race. Already the holder of Section 5's best at 2:37.6, he tried to set a slower pace and held the lead

until Liverpool's Joe Head took over at the half-way mark. Watts made a bid for another comeback win in the last 50 meters, but Head turned on his own kick and won in 2:40.8. Watts ran a good 2:41.3.

The McQuaid junior also has the top 800 mark (1:59.7), and is among the leaders in the 300 (38.2 seconds) and 1600 (4:40.1).

Senior Eric Garsin has area bests in the 1500 and 1600, the latter coming at Hamilton in an eyelash 4:30.7 victory over Utica's John Syrotinski. Garsin found himself in fifth place behind teammate Adam Reitz with three laps to go, but he worked his way into the lead in the next 300. He seemed on his way to a comfortable win before Syrotinski's closing spurt just missed nipping him. Reitz was third in a PR 4:33.3.

Garsin, the area leader in the 1500 (4:16.4), also had the best 3200 time (10:00) until teammate Dan Lesser topped that with a 9:52.3 at Hamilton. Lesser, the 3000 leader with a fast 9:12.8 at Brown last month, hooked up with Rome's Eric Foley, one of upstate's top distance men for four years. Foley jumped right into the lead and never let Lesser pass him.

"Dan must have tried 10 times," said Bradley, "but Foley picked it up just enough to keep him out and then

outkicked him." In the same race, senior Matt Bunce kept contact with Lesser most of the way and wound up fourth with a PR 10:05.5.

Lesser and Garsin both returned to run 800 legs on winning relays. Lesser's 2:09.9 anchor was good enough to give the Knights a sprint medley win, with senior Mark Beresiewicz running the 400 leadoff and Tim Tyre and Bunce handling the 200 legs. Garsin's 2:05.4 leadoff opened up a good lead for McQuaid's 3200-meter team, and it won easily on good efforts by Dave Corsall (2:12.4), Jim Barnum (2:11.8), and Reitz (2:07.9).

The Knights' 3200 team posted an area best over the Christmas break when they traveled to the Brown University Invitational and finished fourth in 8:20.4. Garsin, Bunce, Watts, and Barnum combined for that effort, but Bradley expects to have Reitz and senior Tim Kelley in the lineup by season's end. Kelley has missed the last four meets after undergoing an emergency appendectomy on Christmas night.

"It seems strange not to see Tim's name on the list of bests because he's been there for three years. But he should be able to practice again soon and maybe even get into competition in a month."

The trip to Providence also produced the fastest indoor distance medley Section 5 has had since the Knights posted a 10:22.3 at Yale in 1985. This time, the clock showed a modest 10:42.1, coming from a 1200 by Garsin (3:13.2), a 54.1 400 by Joe Tiffany, a 1:59.9 800 by Watts, and Lesser's 4:34.9 anchor leg of 1600. That brought them a fifth place in an elite race of 11 top teams from the Northeast. Chaminade High of Long Island won in 10:31.

At Hamilton, McQuaid's third winning relay was the 800-meter team, which had its fastest time of the season, 1:38.2. Last year's record-setting (1:33.9) group has been replaced with a senior-soph combination of Tiffany and Beresiewicz and newcomers Tim Tyre and Alan LaChapelle. On Saturday, Tiffany's 24.2 lead-off got his team right out there, and Beresiewicz's 24.3 anchor put the Knights in position for the win when Henninger was disqualified for a zone violation.

The Knights' final eight points came from high-jumpers Tiffany and Brian Kubiak, who tied for third with 5-8. Their team total of 92 topped Henninger's 70 and Rome Free's 66 among eight A-schools.

This weekend's RWTL action at the University of Rochester shifts to a Friday night slot, beginning at 5 p.m.

Reitz, Tiffany pace McQuaid trackmen

Junior Adam Reitz and senior Joe Tiffany shared top honors for McQuaid's indoor track team in last Friday's RWTL meet at the University of Rochester.

Reitz, who's been developing his middle distance skills as a change of pace from a steady distance diet, had the fastest 800-meter time of the long evening, 2:05.4. He took the lead after 300 meters, went through his 400 is sub-60, and won comfortably over a field that included teammates Dan Lesser (a PR 2:06.6) and Jim Barnum (2:10.4).

In a previous RWTL meet, Reitz had won a fast 600 (1:29.2) to go with the good times in his usual events, the 1600 and 3200.

Earlier he and Tiffany had run

strong legs on McQuaid's winning 4 x 2-lap relay team. Senior Mark Beresiewicz's lead-off leg was the key for the Knights, said McQuaid coach Bob Bradley. "The U of R track is not an easy one to pass on, and Mark made a great move right at the start to get us out into the lead. Reitz extended that margin slightly, and junior Jim Barnum kept his team in front for the pass to Tiffany. Edison's anchor man challenged for the lead, but Tiffany pulled away on the final lap.

Tiffany just missed a double win in the hurdles, being nipped by an Edison runner while posting a PR 6.0 for the 40-meter event.

In the 200-meter races, a new distance for RWTL meets, McQuaid's young sophomore sprinters all showed

well. Tim Tyre had the fastest time of the Knight entries, a 25.8 that earned him a second place. Next were Alan LaChapelle (26.2), Marc Corea (26.6), and Alex Perez (26.7).

Seniors Rob Bradley (4:42.6) and Jesse Yeager (4:44.0) placed third and fourth in their section of the 1500, a race won by Brighton's C.R. Gash.

In field events, shotputter Harry Gill and triple jumper Greg Schlachter both had PR's, though neither placed.

This Saturday, McQuaid will join a few other Section 5 entries in the annual Western New York Relays hosted by Section 6, this year at the spacious University of Buffalo arena, beginning at 2 p.m. The Knights will also have entries in the local RWTL meet at U of R, beginning at 10:30 a.m.

McQuaid runners travel to Princeton and West Point

Two quality meets on consecutive days gave McQuaid Jesuit's traveling relay men a chance at some great competition last weekend and the Knights responded with some of their best races so far this season.

In Saturday's Princeton Relays, a combination of seniors Tim Kelley and Eric Garsin and juniors Dan Lesser and Adam Reitz teamed up for a fast 8:06.8 in the 3200-meter relay. That locked them into a stretch duel with Henderson (Pa.) High School, who prevailed on the final lap in 8:05.1.

Lesser's 2:04.8 lead-off gave the Knights good contact in sixth place, and Kelley, after falling back to eighth, went to work for a 2:00.8 that touched Garsin off in second. Garsin's 2:01.3 brought his team almost even with

Henderson, and Reitz came up with a 1:59.9 that fell just short of victory. The McQuaid anchorman forged into the lead with 300 meters to go, but Henderson's anchor came right back into first and held Reitz off on the last lap.

McQuaid's time is the fourth fastest in the East this season and puts the Knights on track for their Project X goal of breaking the school's long-standing indoor mark of 7:52.0. "That's one of the fastest times we've run this early," said assistant coach Dave Warth.

Garsin did double duty at Princeton, running in the invitational 1500 and finishing seventh in a PR 4:10.3. The McQuaid senior stayed off the fast-opening pace and never was able to

move higher than sixth in the elite field of 14.

After an overnight stay at the Jesuit retreat house in Cornwall, N.Y., the McQuaid contingent had just a short hop down the Palisades to the West Point Invitational. Lesser and Reitz were first up, and the two juniors ran PR's of 9:00.06 and 9:05.7 in the 3000, good for fourth and fifth places. The pair led the field through a 4:47 mile before giving way to a Long Island trio led by Matt Moran of St. Anthony's who won the race in 8:55.39.

The Knights switched to the distance medley relay for this meet and again saw a good performance net them only runner-up medals. This time the victors wore the familiar colors of Fairport High, whose 10:42.5 edged McQuaid's 10:43.6.

"The two teams just dominated the race. It was like a dual meet," said Warth. Kelley led off with a 2:03.2, senior Joe Tiffany had a PR 52.8 for his 400 leg, and Garsin popped an outstanding 3:11.1 1200 to give the Knights the lead for the first time. For seven laps, Lesser held on to his narrow margin, but Fairport's Teague Ruder made a winning move in the last 200.

Tiffany, in addition to his relay stint, also continued his quest for the school's pole vault record, clearing 12-6 and having a narrow miss at the record of 13-0.

Back in Rochester, Tiffany's vault partner, sophomore Greg Schlachter, upped his indoor PR to 11-0, placing second at the weekly RWTL meet at U of R.

Three other Knights came up with sectional qualifying performances in their events. Sophomore Tim Tyre ran his first 600 of the season and posted a 1:36.1. Junior Jim Barnum had his first crack ever at the 1600 and qualified with a 4:57.8, while junior Ian Sohn had a 15-second breakthrough in the 3200 and qualified with a 10:52.3.

In the latter race, freshman Jeff Clark improved his time to 10:36.9 and soph Pat Bernal chopped off 18 seconds with an 11:07.9. Indoor athletes have two more chances to make the sectional standards before the Section 5 championships, scheduled for Feb. 20, at Roberts Wesleyan.

This weekend RWTL action moves to Seneca Falls for a meet at New York Chiropractic College on Saturday.

McQuaid wins 2 relays

Two relay victories and a meet record highlighted the McQuaid indoor track men's frigid visit last Saturday to St. Lawrence University for the Section 10 Invitational.

Junior Jim Barnum was part of both winning relays, running lead-off on the 3,200 team that won handily in 8:34.8, and contributing a decisive third leg on the 1,600 foursome that held off Franklin Academy with a 3:41.1. Barnum also ran a PR 1:31.3 on the 600.

Joining Barnum in the first race were Matt Bunce, Dan Lesser, and Tim Kelley. In the nip-and-tuck 1,600 race, Eric Garsin led off, Adam Reitz gave Barnum the lead, and Barnum, after being passed by his Franklin opponent, came back and pulled away to give anchorman Joe Tiffany 20 yards to work with. A 54.6 anchor, almost identical to the fast 54.7's recorded by Reitz and Barnum, clinched the win.

Tiffany also accounted for a meet

record in the hurdles, winning his section on time in a 7.9 that also tied the McQuaid school record. Teammate Mark Beresiewicz ran an 8.3 to take second.

Beresiewicz also had a productive day, placing second in the 300 with a PR 38.4, and anchoring McQuaid's improving sprint relay team to a second in the 640-meter event.

The 300 saw another PR, by almost a second, from sophomore Tim Tyre, who was third in 38.7. Tyre's day also included a 6.8 55-meter dash that placed him sixth, and a sharp lead-off leg on the spring relay. Fellow sophs Alan LaChapelle and Alex Perez completed the sprint team.

McQuaid's middle-distance and distance men had a mixed day, coming up with some PRs but generally not matching their impressive performance of recent weeks. In the seeded 1,600, Garsin suffered a spill in the early going and wound up third in 4:32.4. In the same race, Reitz ran with the leaders through a fast 2.12 first half before fading and winding up unplaced.

The same pair fared much better in the 1,000, hitting PRs of 2:37.2 and 2:43.3. Reitz took the early pace, but

Garsin passed him to go after the winner, Watertown's George Wright, who posted a meet record of 2:34.4.

In the unseeded 1,600, senior Jesse Yeager not only won but also hit a sectional qualifying time of 4:56.3 with a fast final quarter of 71. Classmates Rob Bradley and Dave Corsall were close behind, both timed in just over five minutes.

Senior Tim Kelley also made his qualifying standard in the 600 with a 1:29.8, good for fifth place.

In the 3,000, McQuaid's Dan Lesser and Matt Bunce ran 1-2 for most of the first mile, but wound up 4-5. Lesser's time of 9:28.9 was almost 30 seconds off his best, while Bunce's 9:31.2 was a PR.

Most of McQuaid's field men competed in the RWTL meet in relatively

balmy Seneca Falls (it was minus-20 degrees in Canton), but pole-vaulter Greg Schlachter cleared 11 feet to place second. Tiffany, a 12-6 vaulter in his previous two meets, had only 10-6 for fourth.

Highlighting the Seneca Falls action for the Knights was junior Brian Kubiak's first indoor clearance of 6 feet, putting him among Section 5's best in that event.

This weekend the McQuaid squad will again split between the final RWTL meet Friday at Roberts Wesleyan and the annual Southern Tier Classic at the SUNY College at Cortland on Saturday. The Knights are defending champions in the latter meet, which will be the last tune-up for the following Saturday's sectionals.

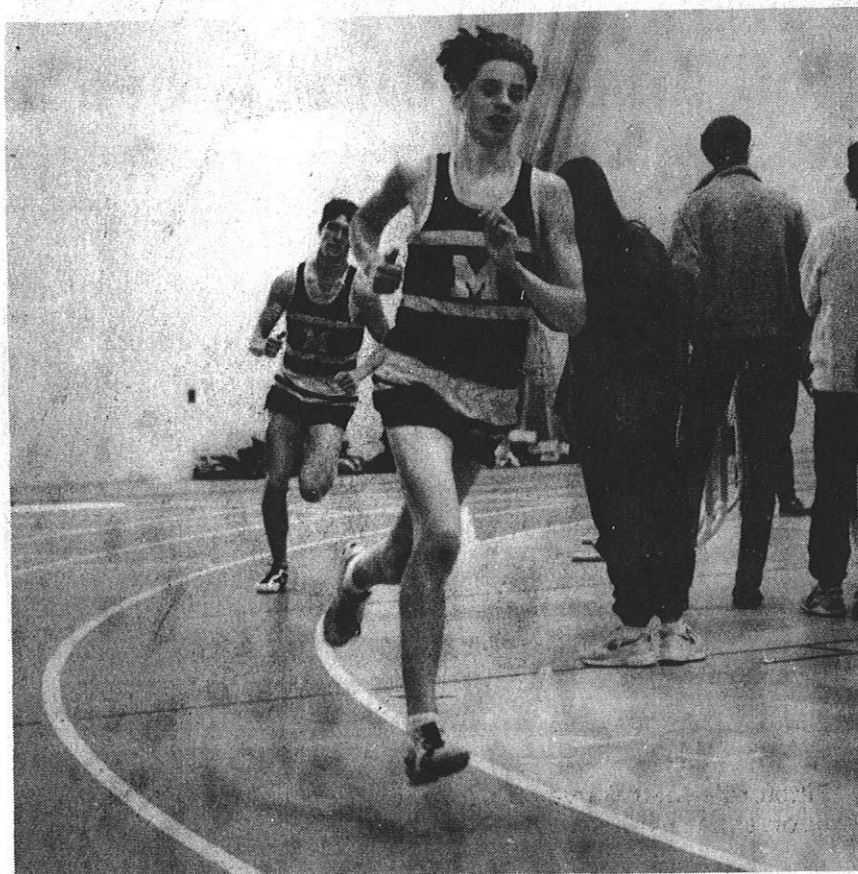

A strong showing in the running events wasn't enough to carry McQuaid Jesuit's indoor track and field team to another Section Five championship on Saturday at Roberts Wesleyan. The Knights raced to five firsts and 102 points to outscore Fairport by 16 on the track,, but the Red Raiders piled up an overwhelming 44 point margin in five field events and walked off with the trophy by a 141.5-113.5 score.

McQuaid came out swinging with a 1-2-3 in the first running final, the 3200. Dan Lesser won his first individual patch with a 9:54.8, and Eric Garsin, running his first distance race in 6 weeks, worked his way up to second in 10:09.1. Adam Reitz, who took the race out fast, held on for third in 10:14, and Matt Bunce, after surging to fourth against Spencerport's Jeff Calabrese and Fairport's Nate Ruder, wound up sixth to complete a 25-point opening round.

The Knights came close to a 1-2 in the 1000, with Shawn Watts running away from the field and coasting in with a 2:39.8. Tim Kelley passed Fairport's top entry, Jeff Brighton, in a bid for second, but the Raiders' Matt Morrison caught Kelley in the last 30 meters to keep McQuaid from widening its lead to 43-9.

Watts came up with another gem in the 600, taking on Fairport's defending champion, Mike Reif, and beating him to the tape by 2 steps (1:26.1) for his second patch in 75 minutes. "That's a tough double in sectional competition, but Shawn handled it beautifully," said coach Bob Bradley, disappointed with the final score but still pleased with his runners' achievements.

In ^{the} 1600, it was sweep time again, and the Knights pulled it off despite formidable presence of Fairport's Ruder and Greece's Tim Lowe. Reitz captured the patch with a strong third quarter move that sent him away to a 4:38.2. Lesser was second in 4:41, and Garsin, the early pace-setter, third ⁱⁿ 4:44.1 ^{victory}

With Fairport scoring heavily in the field, McQuaid's huge early lead was all but gone heading into the 300, and by a difference of two-tenths of a second, it disappeared. Watts was the Knights' top entry, and his seed time put him in the next-to-fast section. Going all-out in an effort to spring an upset against the clock, Watts ran out of gas in the final few strides and was nipped by Fairport's Jon Goosey, both timed in 38.2. In the next race, Penfield's Jermaine Blue won as expected in 36.7, and Fairport's duo of ~~Matt Gaffney~~ and Brian McEvoy came across together in 38.1. That left Watts in fifth with 2 points and the Fairport trio with a 2-3-4, good for 18 points. McQuaid soph Tim Tyre ran a strong 38.9 for the sixth. "The 300 didn't decide the meet," said Bradley, "but it was the single biggest turn-around in terms of Fairport pushing McQuaid back instead of vice-versa. Shawn gave it everything he had, but Fairport's sprinters came through when they had to."

The Knights had two more high spots, though, and hurdler Joe Tiffany produced one in the next event with a school record 7.2 that just missed upsetting the area's top hurdler, Fairport's Pete Meyer.

The 3200 relay provided the last big chunk of points, as McQuaid

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came from behind on the second leg and won easily over the Raiders. Tim Kelley kept his team close on the lead-off leg, giving Bunce a chance to take the lead on the last lap of his leg. Lesser then opened a wide margin for Garsin to stride home with a a 10-second victory.

With the outcome already decided, McQuaid and Fairport had one last battle in the 800-meter relay, and appropriately it was the Raiders edging the Knights in what turned out to be a battle for third and fourth place behind Edison and Marshall.

In the field events, McQuaid managed just 11.5 points, but six of them came on a personal best 12-foot vault from sophomore Greg Schlachter. "That was one of th best moments of the meet," said Bradley. "Greg's been getting a lot of help from volunteer coach Greg Garland, and it paid off at the right time. It's great to see a young competitor come through in the clutch."

The Knights' other points came from Brian Kubiak with a 5-10 high jump that tied for third and Dave Rimlinger's 5-8 that earned him a tie for sixth. In the shot put, though not scoring, senior Harry Gill had a two-foot breakthrough with a 40-11 1/4, and Adam Missell threw a PR 39-5.

Junior Jim Barnum and freshman Jeff Clark also had excellent non-scoring races, Clark with a 10:39.3 3200 and Barnum with a 1:31.3 600 that missed sixth by just a tenth. In the 1600, seniors Jesse Yeager and Rob Bradley each had PR's, 4:53.6 and 4:54.4, to finish eighth and ninth.

"We gave Fairport a great run," said Bradley, "but they had too many guns today. I though Scott Murray was particularly outstanding, winning the pole vault and high jump when they were going on at the same time." The Raiders scored in every event, matching McQuaid's feat of last year, and also broke the Knights' sectional scoring record of 125.

McQuaid's top men move on to tonight's Meet of Champions at Roberts, beginning at 5 PM, to qualify individuals and relays for the State Meet at Cornell on March 6th. In the interim, the Knights' 3200 relay will bid for its third Eastern States championship in next Monday night's meet at Princeton.
