## Healthy Burke is back to form

Sperry senior wins 3,200 run; McQuaid captures team title

Rush-Henrietta's Joe Burke again is able to make his move — a backstretch bolt that often leads to a first-place finish.

After suffering through a painful indoor track and field season with an Achilles injury, then a knee strain, the high school distance runner yesterday showed his Aquinas Relays competition that he has returned to top form.

Burke, a senior at Sperry who plans to continue his education and athletics next year at SUNY-Farmingdale, raced away from the 3,200-meter field and finished first in a personal best time of 9:22.2.

"I didn't think I could beat that kid from Brooklyn Tech," Burke said, referring to second-place finisher Miguel Matos. "I just wanted to hang with him. When I made my move I thought he'd be right behind me. I thought he'd move with me, but he didn't."

Burke was not the only local athlete who successfully put the moves on Brooklyn Tech's entries at the University of Rochester's Fauver Stadium.

McQuaid, the area's top-ranked team, outdistanced the three-time defending champion and 37 other boys' teams to gain its fifth team title in the relays' 21-year history. The Knights finished with 57 team points, while

Brooklyn Tech, the only other five-time team champion, had 48.

Liverpool of Section 3 (Syracuse area) placed third with 38 points, Syracuse Henninger was fourth with 34 points and R-H finished fifth with 24.

"It really was a team effort," McQuaid Coach Bill Quinlisk said. "Our weight men, hurdlers, jumpers, sprinters and distance men all did what they are capable of doing."

The Knights won one event — the 3,200 relay — and finished second in five others — the discus, long jump, 440 shuttle hurdles, distance medley and 1,600 relays.

The team of Tim Hanley, Chris McGuire, and Tim and Dave Warth were responsible for McQuaid's only first, running 3,200 meters in 8:05.7.

McQuaid's victory in the 3,200 relay was

one of five first places posted by Rochester-area competitors. Included among the firsts was a Section 5 record by East in the 400 relay (:42.9), a meet record by Palmyra-Macedon's Steve Kuntz in the high jump (six feet, seven inches), and a personal best by Geneva's John Arthur in the pole vault (13-0).

East lowered its own Section 5 record in the 400 relay by 3/10ths of a second without one of its regulars in the lineup. Freshman Derrick Moody substituted as the team's leadoff runner for senior Carlton Davis, who arrived late and missed the qualifying heat. Juniors Terry Richards, Ken Burke and LaVonne Richards then took their regular places on the sprint team.

East's chances for a double in the 800 ended in a qualifying heat when the Orientals were disqualified for handing off the baton out of the passing zone. Section 5's indoor champions could only watch as Syracuse Henninger established a meet record (1:29.6) in the final.

"Disqualifications are unfortunate things," said race director and Aquinas Coach Tom Gigliotti. "But in any sport, you're going to have errors on the part of the athletes."

Brooklyn Tech Coach Ed Zarowin, who is retiring after this, his 22nd season, can attest to that.

Brooklyn Tech had run the fourth-fastest qualifying time in the 400 relay, but was disqualified for false starting in the final. As a result, the Engineers did not score in that event, while McQuaid placed fifth and picked up two team points.

"Brooklyn Tech did not have the field event people," said Gigliotti, "and the false start in the 400 was just a killer."

Brooklyn Tech won two events — the shuttle hurdles (behind state high hurdle favorite Dirk Morris) and the 1,600 relay — but McQuaid proved it had what Gigliotti referred to as "better balance across the boards."

**NOTES:** Kuntz, the reigning Section 5 high jump champion, had cleared 6-7 ear-

lier in the week, but it did not count. "Two days ago I jumped 6-7, but it was a scrimmage so it didn't count," said the 6-5 senior who will study electrical engineering and high jump next year at Cornell. "I was hoping I'd get 6-7 today so it would count." He reached 6-7 despite windy conditions, then missed on his first two attempts at that height. His third and final attempt was a success — and it counted . . . Liverpool junior **J.J. Grant** showed why he is considered the state's best weight man. The defending state shot put champion led his team to a first place with a toss of 61-6½. He also had the meet's best discus throw (165-6) in helping his team to a fifth in that event . . . Lyons' **King Lewis** was another athlete whose individual performance stood out on a day reserved mostly for relay laurels. The sophomore had a long jump of 22-6½ . . . State cross country champion Clarence set a meet record in the distance medley relay with a time of 10:29.2. The Section 6 (Buffalo area) school also finished first in the 6,400 relay behind standout **Dan Garrett**.

# Seconds make McQuaid No. 1 in boys' Class A Knights have the depth to win track sectionals

Most of the trophies collected by McQuaid's track and field team earlier this month at the Aquinas Relays were for second-place finishes. But those seconds added up to the "big first place" as the Knights showed why they are considered the Rochester area's No. 1 team.

That same balance, which kept McQuaid unbeaten through the regular season (6-0 in dual meets, 4-0 in invitationals), promises to carry the Knights to the Section 5 Class A boys' championship Saturday at Brockport State.

But McQuaid Coach Bill Quinlisk wonders, "Are our second-line kids going to get the seconds like they did at the Aquinas Relays?"

"Taking nothing away from the great individuals," he said yesterday, "we're looking at Rush-Henrietta as the biggest threat in the team competition. The question is, 'Do we have enough depth to combat their first-place strength?'"

R-H, a champion of the past three sectional championships (one outdoor and two indoors), has potential first-place finishers in 110- and 400-meter hurdler Martin Ellis and 3,200 runner Joe Burke.

But, said Penfield Coach Dave Hennessey, "In the events where Rush-Henrietta has first-place strength, McQuaid is capable of picking up points. That should negate some of Rush-Henrietta's strength."

Hennessey joined the chorus in declaring

McQuaid the team to beat.

"They're No. 1," he said, referring to the Knights' ranking in the *Democrat and Chronicle* coaches poll. "Now's the time they have to live up to it."

Fairport, the top-ranked girls' team, is favored to retain its Class A title, although five other teams could threaten. In Class B, defending champion Newark and runner-up Dansville promise to again battle for the girls' team title, while Midlakes and Dansville are the top boys' teams.

The Class A and B boys' and girls' championships will begin at 10 a.m. Saturday. Classes C and D start at noon tomorrow at Brockport State with East Rochester (Class C boys), Lyons (C girls) and Alfred-Almond (Class D boys and girls) defending titles.

The weather forecast for those two days calls for scattered showers, but, as Quinlisk said, "If you're from Rochester and you're not used to running in the rain, you haven't been running this spring."

McQuaid's Chris McGuire and Dave Warth have been running in all conditions this spring. They are among the area's best performers in their respective events — McGuire in the 400 (49.8 seconds) and Warth in the 800 (1:58.9).

McQuaid's 1,600 and 3,200 relay teams join McGuire as top seeds.

Having registered one of the area's best times or distances during the season is no guarantee for success at the sectionals, however.

"I expect a lot of surprises," said Hennessey, "and a lot of top seeds to be knocked off."

## Coach's presence aids East's track recruiting

East's success in outdoor track and field began inside the Rochester city high school.

"The difference (in this year's team) is my being in the building," Coach Jeff Slack said Saturday during a break at the Aquinas Relays. "That helps a lot. The last couple of years the coach wasn't a teacher at the school."

"I did a lot of recruiting and got some kids who play other sports to come out. In this sport, more than any other, you need numbers."

The numbers East has put together this spring are winning point totals. Last week, for instance, the Orientals dumped two top-10 teams — Aquinas and Cardinal Mooney — to leap from honorable mention to No. 5 in the *Democrat and Chronicle* Section 5 coaches poll.

Slack did not have to convince sprinters Ken Burke and Terry and LaVonne Richards to come out for the team at East. Those three — joined by senior Carlton Davis — won the section's 800-meter relay title during the indoor season. Then Saturday at the University of Rochester's Fauver Stadium, freshman Derrick Moody joined the three juniors on a Section 5-record run in the 400 relay (:42.9).

"Those kids have been running together for so long," said Slack. "That's a plus right away. All I have to do is keep them mentally ready to run."

East (3-1) is one of three newcomers to the boys' track top 10 — joining No. 7 Spencerport (3-1) and No. 9 Franklin (3-1).

McQuaid (4-0) remained the unanimous choice for No. 1 after winning its fifth Aquinas Relays title in the meet's 21-year history. The Knights, who will visit East for a City-Catholic League Division 1 dual meet at 3:45 this afternoon, still are followed by No. 2 Penfield (5-1), No. 3 Rush-Henrietta (3-1) and No. 4 Hilton (4-0).
